Summary of CV

Maria Kapanadze is the Vice-President of the European Network of Occupational Therapy in Higher Education (ENOTHE) from 2019. She holds research professor position at the University School of Nursing and Occupational Therapy of Terrassa (EUIT/UAB). She is a PhD in Psychology by the University of Girona (Spain) with an international mention (University of British Columbia), Excellent Cum Laude. Also, she is BSc/MSc in Psychology, BSc in Occupational Therapy, and MSc in Inclusive Education. She graduated as the second generation of occupational therapists of Georgia in 2007 from Ilia State University's (ILIAUNI) European Project, developed in collaboration with the European Network of Occupational Therapy in Higher Education (ENOTHE). This education permitted her to contribute to the project development and establishment of OT role in Georgia in spheres of palliative care, working with children with homelessness experiences, job insertion of people with learning disabilities, and inclusive vocational education. Her professional experience in Spain includes project development in social settings with vulnerable populations (career counselling and job insertion projects with immigrants, refugees, and people in recovery from substance use disorders; group and individual therapy, working with trauma, recovery-oriented peer- topeer projects). Her professional career combines research, teaching and intervention related to occupational science and psychology. Her research focuses on ethical aspects of an occupation, moral identity, social determinants of health, prevention of long-term unemployment, employability and recovery-oriented practices. She presented her works at different scientific international forums in UK (Oxford, Edinburg, York), Ireland (Galway, Cork), Turkey (Ankara), Georgia (Tbilisi), France (Alénya), Portugal (Lisbon), Spain (Terrassa, Barcelona, Vic, Granada, Sitges), Belgium (Gent, Bruges), Russia (Rostov-on-Don), Canada (Vancouver, Winnipeg).

The research, academic and professional profile in the fields of psychology and occupational therapy allow me to set the following main objectives/goals for further career development:

1. Development of research projects related to health sciences, moral psychology, occupational science, ethical aspects related to employment, social determinants of health and social justice, employability and population at risk of social exclusion. The competencies related to methodological aspects are reflected in the application of mixed research: qualitative approaches (phenomenology), quantitative and quasi-experimental.

My primer motivation for professional growth is connected to scientific production and acquiring experience in the management of research teams.

The field of moral psychology and occupational science opens up a wide range of potential lines of research that could contribute to the psychological and occupational health of individuals and/or groups on a national and international scale.

- 2. Contribution to the development of European policies. My role as a Vice-President of European Network of Occupational Therapy in Higher Education permits me to contribute to the European and international health care policies.
- 3. Commitment to innovative teaching, incorporating service-learning and internationalisation projects. I believe that the application of different educational methodologies, such as problem-based learning, project-centred education, experiential/situated learning and creativity, are effective tools that accompany the teaching tasks. These projects allow the reality of the university to be adjusted to the demands of the changing social environment. However, in professions such as psychology and occupational therapy, it is essential to transmit a passion and enthusiasm for evidence-based practice. This section's particular interest and professional objectives are connected with acquiring competencies for curricular development at BSc, MSc, PhD, and postgraduate levels.
- 4. Development of intervention projects in the social field. Experience in psychotherapy and individual and group occupational therapy allows me to study in-depth interventions and project design in mental health, drug addiction, palliative care and people at risk of social exclusion.

The transversal skills to be highlighted are collaboration in interdisciplinary and work teams, networking, creativity, entrepreneurship and commitment to internationalisation.
